

1. Global Korea Scholarship(GKS)

organized by 'National Institute for Inter -national Education(NIIED)'.





GKS (Global Korea Scholarship)

Programs

- Undergraduate degrees (bachelor)
- Graduate degrees (master / doctoral)

Application tracks

- Embassy track
 - (1st round of selection by Embassy and PRONABEC)
- University track
 (1st round of selection by Univ. directly)

GKS (Global Korea Scholarship)

Period of scholarship

- Bachelor's Degree Program: 5~7 years (1 year of Korean language program + 4~6 years of degree program)
- Master's Degree Program: 3 years
 - (1 year of Korean language program + 2 years of degree program)
- Doctoral Degree Program: 4 years

(1 year of Korean language program + 3 years of degree program)

X Only scholars who achieve at least level 3 on TOPIK by the end of one-year Korean language program can proceed to the degree program. (Exception - There are some majors that require higher than level 3)

X Students who acquired level 5 on TOPIK are exempted from taking Korean language program

Beneficios Cubiertos por GKS

- Airfare at the time of initial entry and final departure (economy class – actual expense)
- Settlement allowance
- Monthly allowance
- Medical insurance
- Korean language training fee
- Tuition

Korean proficiency grants

• If a GKS scholar withdraws from the scholarship within the first 3 months after entering Korea, one MUST return the full scholarship amount that she/he has received after being selected as a GKS scholar.

Embassy Track schedule

Applications open

- Applicants must submit documents in pdf file to PRONABEC by the deadline
- Number of Vacancies 1~2 (Undergrate), 5~6 (Graduate)

Document screening (1st round)

• Embassy and PRONABEC select interviewees

Interview (1st round)

• Embassy and PRONABEC select best candidates within the quota

2nd Round of Selection

• NIIED reviews the applications of candidates selected at the 1st round

3rd Round of Selection

• Applications are reviewed by Universities where they initially applied to

Eligibility

> Nationality : Peruvian

X All applicants and their parents must NOT hold Korean citizenship

- Age : under 25 (Undergraduate) under 40 (Graduate)
- Grades (from their previous degree program) : Score percentile should be 80% or above on a 100-point scale OR be ranked within the top 20% within one's class OR C.G.P.A must be above following criteria

※ C.G.P.A (Cumulative Grade Point Average)

: above 2.64 / 4.0, 2.80 / 4.3, 2.91 / 4.5, 3.23 / 5.0

> **Health** : All applicants must be in good health



Eligibility

Level of Education :

- Bachelor's Degree Program is for applicants who graduated (or are expected to graduate) from <u>a high school or</u> from an associate degree program

 Associate Degree Program is for applicants who graduated (or are expected to graduate) from <u>a high school</u>
 For undergraduate program, applicants who graduated from a high school can apply, but who hold a bachelor's degree already are NOT eligible

- Master's Program Applicant must hold a <u>bachelor's</u> <u>degree</u> or a level of education equivalent to or higher than a bachelor's degree

- Doctoral Program Applicant must hold a <u>master's degree</u> or a level of education equivalent to or higher than a master's degree

Required Documents

- Application form with personal statement, study plan, agreement and health check forms
- Certificates to prove the eligibility (graduation certificate, transcript, proof of citizenship(applicant and parents) etc.)
- Single letter of recommendation
- Certificate of English Proficiency test (optional) TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS are preferable
- Certificate of TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) is optional, but applicants who hold a TOPIK level 3 or above will get additional points
- All applicant documents must be written either in Korean or English

Evaluation Preference

Additional Points

Applicants who hold a TOPIK level 3 or above will be given additional points (10% of the total allocated points in document evaluation)

Evaluation Preference


- Overseas Koreans
- Applicants from low-income families or underprivileged background
- Applicants who submit a high score of English proficiency test (TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS)
- Applicants who applied for a natural science and engineering department in a regional university in Korea
- (Relevant to associate degree applicants) Winner of a national level competition on technical skills

Example : Study Plan

- Study plans to improve Korean/English languages ability required for taking a degree course BEFORE and AFTER you come to Korea.
- Goal of study and detailed study plan
- Future plan in Korea or another country after finishing GKS program

Interview by Embassy and PRONABEC

- Motives and career plan
- Knowledge about Korea
- > Adapting to life in Korea / Personality, interpersonal skills
- > Attitude
- English proficiency, etc.
- Final candidates who renounce their scholarship CANNOT reapply for the GKS program in the future.
- Embassy track applicant who has not passed the first round of selection may apply to a university track as long as they can meet the application deadline of the re-applying university.



(NIIED) 2nd Round of Selection

- Study in Korea (www.studyinkorea.go.kr) > Scholarship
 - > GKS Notice board
- (Universities) 3rd Round of Selection
- Announcement of final scholars
 - late-June (Graduate), late-December (Undergraduate)

Checklist

> [Embassy Track]

- Applicants can choose up to THREE different universities
- X Applicants cannot choose three different departments from a single university
- Of the chosen universities, at least one university must be from Type B universities

[University Track]

University track applicants should fill in ONE university in their application
